**Addendum to
Request for written opinion regarding a possible violation of the *Canada Elections Act*,
Subs. 482(b) by Mr. David Emerson, M.P.**

As set out in the three attached affidavits, three of Mr. Emerson's constituents attest that it was primarily his candidacy for the party he later abandoned that caused them to vote for him in the 2006 election. As is evident from the media coverage regarding public reaction to Mr. Emerson's change of party in Vancouver Kingsway, a significant number of Canadian citizens who voted in his favour on January 23 similarly would not have voted for him had he stood for the Conservatives.

Should you need a larger number of affidavits in order to issue my requested written response of March 2, 2006, I will be happy to provide them.
